Educational System

The Spanish education system is designed to provide comprehensive, balanced, and accessible education for all students. It is structured in several stages, from early childhood education to higher education, and is organized under a legal framework that guarantees educational quality and the right to education for everyone.

The Baccalaureate lasts two years and is divided into three main tracks: Biosciences, Humanities/Social Sciences, and Technology. Within each track, students must choose optional subjects based on their interests and the academic path they wish to pursue, especially if they plan to enter university.

The school year in Spain is divided into three terms, beginning in September and ending in June. There are holiday breaks during summer, Christmas, and Easter.

The school works within a fully digital learning environment. Families can access real-time academic information — including grades and teacher feedback — through EDUCAMOS, the school's dedicated digital platform. Students use an iPad (Apple) as their primary learning tool, both in class and at home, reflecting the school's commitment to a modern, future-ready education.

Your Support Network
