Welcome to Language Campus in Gran Canaria

Choosing Language Campus in Gran Canaria is about much more than learning a language. It is a summer of new experiences, shared adventures and friendships that begin in the classroom and grow across the island.

Based in Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, our Summer Camp combines **high-quality language learning** with city life, beaches, local culture and an exciting programme of activities and excursions.

Often described as “a continent in miniature”, Gran Canaria brings together golden dunes, dramatic landscapes, historic neighbourhoods and lively coastal settings within a single island.

Students enjoy an international atmosphere while exploring the destination, practising their language skills and sharing everyday moments with new friends. From lessons and beach activities to days out across the island, each part of the programme adds something different to the experience.

About Language Campus

Our story began in **2006**, sending students abroad as a study-travel agency — work we continue today. In 2008 we founded Language Campus to welcome students to the Canary Islands, and we now host young learners from different countries and backgrounds every summer.

Our teaching approach combines clear learning goals with practical communication. Courses follow the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), with students placed at an appropriate level and their progress monitored throughout the programme.

Our two Gran Canaria centres are located in Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, close to Las Canteras Beach. This coastal setting allows students to combine lessons with the city's everyday life, the Atlantic and the experiences that make the island distinctive.

Classes are led by **qualified and experienced teachers** in modern, comfortable learning spaces. Activities encourage participation and help students build the confidence to use the language naturally.

During the Summer Camp, learning continues through excursions, shared activities and conversations with new friends. Students have opportunities to put their skills into practice while discovering the island and enjoying life as part of an international group.

Where We Are

Our Summer Camp is based in **Las Palmas de Gran Canaria**, on the northeast coast of Gran Canaria in Spain's Canary Islands.

From this lively coastal city, students combine language lessons with beach life and excursions to discover the island's varied landscapes. **Schools, hotels and the beach are all within walking distance of each other.**

- **20 language lessons per week (15 hours)** — English or Spanish, taught by qualified and experienced teachers
- **International groups of up to 20 students** — with dedicated supervision and one monitor per group
- **4-star hotel accommodation** — within walking distance of the school and the beach
- **Full board** — breakfast, lunch and dinner included
- **Airport transfers** — coordinated for arrivals and departures
- **4 half-day activities and excursions per week** — combining culture, sightseeing, beach time and active experiences
- **2 full-day excursions per week** — discovering some of **Gran Canaria's most iconic places and landscapes**



Learning by Doing

At Language Campus, students learn **by using the language**. Our lessons combine practical communication, collaborative tasks and real-life situations, helping young learners take an active part and grow in confidence.

Programmes follow the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) and develop listening, speaking, reading and writing, together with interaction and mediation.

Lessons are adapted to students' levels and learning needs, building on what they already know while introducing new skills in an engaging, supportive environment.

Our qualified and experienced teachers know how to motivate young learners and encourage participation. They make language learning a meaningful part of the summer, with opportunities to use new skills during activities and everyday conversations.

Lessons usually take place in the morning. When group numbers require it, timetables can alternate: one week of morning classes with afternoon activities, the next the other way round.

Example programme only. The order of the days changes between groups and rounds — arrivals and departures are agreed with each agency, so no two groups follow the same sequence. Premium activities are available at an additional cost.

Full-day excursion

Aqualand

Get ready for a day of **water slides, pools and shared excitement at Aqualand**. The park brings together a variety of attractions, from faster-paced rides to more relaxed moments in the water.

Students can enjoy a change of scenery, cool off and spend an active day with their friends. Trying the slides and sharing favourite moments make the visit a lively part of the Summer Camp experience.

It is a day to make the most of the water, the sunshine and the company of the group.

Full-day excursion · Maspalomas Dunes + Puerto Rico

Maspaloma Dunes

Discover one of Gran Canaria's most extraordinary landscapes, where **golden dunes stretch towards the Atlantic**. Their changing shapes, open views and desert-like scenery create a striking contrast with the streets and beaches of Las Palmas.

A visit to Maspalomas offers the chance to take in this distinctive setting and appreciate another side of the island. The dunes and the ocean together provide a memorable backdrop for time spent with the group.

A unique landscape where the desert meets the sea.



Puerto Rico

Set on Gran Canaria's southwest coast, Puerto Rico combines a **golden-sand beach** with a lively seaside atmosphere. It is a place to enjoy the Atlantic, relax by the water and spend time with friends during a day in the south.

The beach and waterfront provide the setting for a day that brings together coastal scenery, time to unwind and the shared experience of discovering the island.

Puerto Rico is usually combined with the Maspalomas Dunes in the same full-day excursion, covering the two landscapes that define the south of the island.

Premium activity · additional cost: water sports, on the day this excursion takes place. Ask about the options offered for your group.

Anfi del mar and Mogán

With its **white sand, turquoise water and palm-lined surroundings**, Anfi del Mar is one of the most inviting places on the south coast — somewhere to relax, swim and spend time together by the sea.

Calm, sheltered water makes it an easy beach for everyone in the group, whatever their swimming experience.

The beach is usually paired with the harbour town of Puerto de Mogán, on the following page: one full day, two very different coastal settings.

A perfect day to enjoy the sun, the Atlantic and the laid-back lifestyle of southern Gran Canaria.



Puerto de Mogán

In Puerto de Mogán, **colourful buildings, flower-filled lanes and a charming waterfront** create a different atmosphere from the beaches of the south.

Students explore the streets around the harbour, cross its small canals and enjoy the character of a fishing village turned seaside town.

Together with Anfi del Mar, the two stops bring beach time and coastal discovery into a single day out in the south of the island.

Premium activity · additional cost: airsoft, on the day this excursion takes place.



Guayadeque Caves

Explore a different side of Gran Canaria in Guayadeque, where **dramatic ravine scenery** and cave buildings reveal a close relationship between landscape and island life.

The area is known for its natural caves, some adapted over time into homes, rural accommodation and restaurants, where the group stops for lunch.

Discovering the ravine brings together natural surroundings, local history and cultural heritage in one distinctive setting, far from the coast.

Holidayworld

Enjoy an outing full of **energy and entertainment** at Holidayworld. Its amusement-park atmosphere brings a different kind of experience to the Summer Camp, with time for students to share the excitement of the visit with their friends.

The group follows the activities arranged for the programme, making the most of the venue and its lively surroundings, and has dinner there before returning to the hotel.

Combined with a daytime excursion, Holidayworld turns one of the longest days of the programme into one of the most memorable.

Half-day activity

Old Town Tour — Vegueta & Triana

Explore the **historic heart of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria** through Vegueta and Triana, two neighbourhoods that reveal different sides of the city.

In Vegueta, cobbled streets, traditional squares and historic buildings tell the story of a city founded in **1478**. Landmarks such as Casa de Colón provide a setting for discovering the island's past while walking through its oldest quarter.

A short walk away, Triana brings elegant architecture, pedestrian streets, shops and cafés into the experience. Together, the two neighbourhoods connect the city's heritage with the everyday life of Las Palmas today.

Half-day activity

Surf Experience at Las Canteras

Las Canteras is one of the most distinctive places in Las Palmas de Gran Canaria and a natural setting for discovering the island's surfing culture.

A **professionally guided surf session** gives students the opportunity to experience the Atlantic from a board, adapted to their level — whether they are trying surfing for the first time or already have some experience.

Students practise new skills, build confidence in the water and share the excitement of learning with their group.

An active way to enjoy the coast and experience a different side of life at Las Canteras.



Half-day activity

Beach Sports at Las Alcaravaneras

Enjoy an **active day by the sea** at Las Alcaravaneras, one of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria's urban beaches. Its sheltered setting and central location make it a convenient place to combine beach activities with time on the water.

Students take part in **beach volleyball** and team games with their group, making the most of the outdoor setting.

With the city close by and the Atlantic around them, participants have another opportunity to communicate, work together and enjoy the camp beyond the classroom.

Beach Sports at Las Alcaravaneras

On another afternoon, the group swaps the sand for the water: **kayaking and paddleboarding** in the calm, protected bay, with instructors and all the equipment provided.

No experience is needed. Balancing on a board or paddling as a pair turns out to be one of the easiest ways to end up speaking a new language without noticing.

Half-day activity

Elder Science Museum

At the Elder Museum of Science and Technology, **curiosity is part of the visit.** Hands-on exhibits invite students to explore scientific ideas through interaction, making science and technology accessible beyond the classroom.

Interactive displays, a real aircraft and the museum's planetarium offer different ways to investigate the world around us and look beyond it.

Students can follow their interests, ask questions and share what catches their attention. The visit brings a change of pace to the programme, combining discovery with an engaging experience in the heart of Las Palmas.

Las Arenas Shopping Centre

Close to Las Canteras Beach, Las Arenas offers a convenient setting for a **relaxed break** in the programme. Students can explore shops, browse for souvenirs and enjoy the atmosphere of one of the city's shopping and leisure centres.

With cafés, restaurants and a range of stores, the visit provides time to enjoy a different side of Las Palmas alongside the camp's lessons, excursions and outdoor activities.

Half-day activity

Poema del Mar

Step into an **underwater world** at Poema del Mar, where different habitats reveal the variety of life found in and around the oceans.

The visit moves from lush jungle environments to colourful coral reefs before reaching the Deep Sea exhibit. Its panoramic viewing window offers a striking perspective on marine life and creates one of the most memorable moments of the experience.

As students explore, the aquarium provides opportunities to notice the connections between habitats, biodiversity and ocean conservation.

Explore the ocean. Discover a world beneath the surface.



Half-day activity

Arucas & Teror

Discover two towns that reveal Gran Canaria's **architectural heritage** and local character. In Arucas, the Church of San Juan Bautista stands out for its dark local stone and striking detail. The surrounding streets offer an opportunity to explore the town's traditional buildings and atmosphere.

The journey continues to Teror, known for Canarian houses with wooden balconies and the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pine. Walking through the town brings these features into view alongside its streets and squares.

Together, the two visits offer a closer look at the island's history and architecture, adding a cultural dimension to the camp's mix of coastal and outdoor experiences.

More than a Language Course

A summer abroad is made up of more than the places you visit. It is also the conversations before a lesson, the teamwork during an activity and the everyday moments shared with new friends.

At Language Campus, students become part of an **international camp community**, with opportunities to use English or Spanish in different settings throughout their stay.

In class, teachers encourage participation and help students develop their skills. Beyond the classroom, excursions and group activities offer new reasons to communicate, discover common interests and grow in confidence.

These shared experiences help make the island feel familiar and give students something personal to take home from their summer in Gran Canaria.



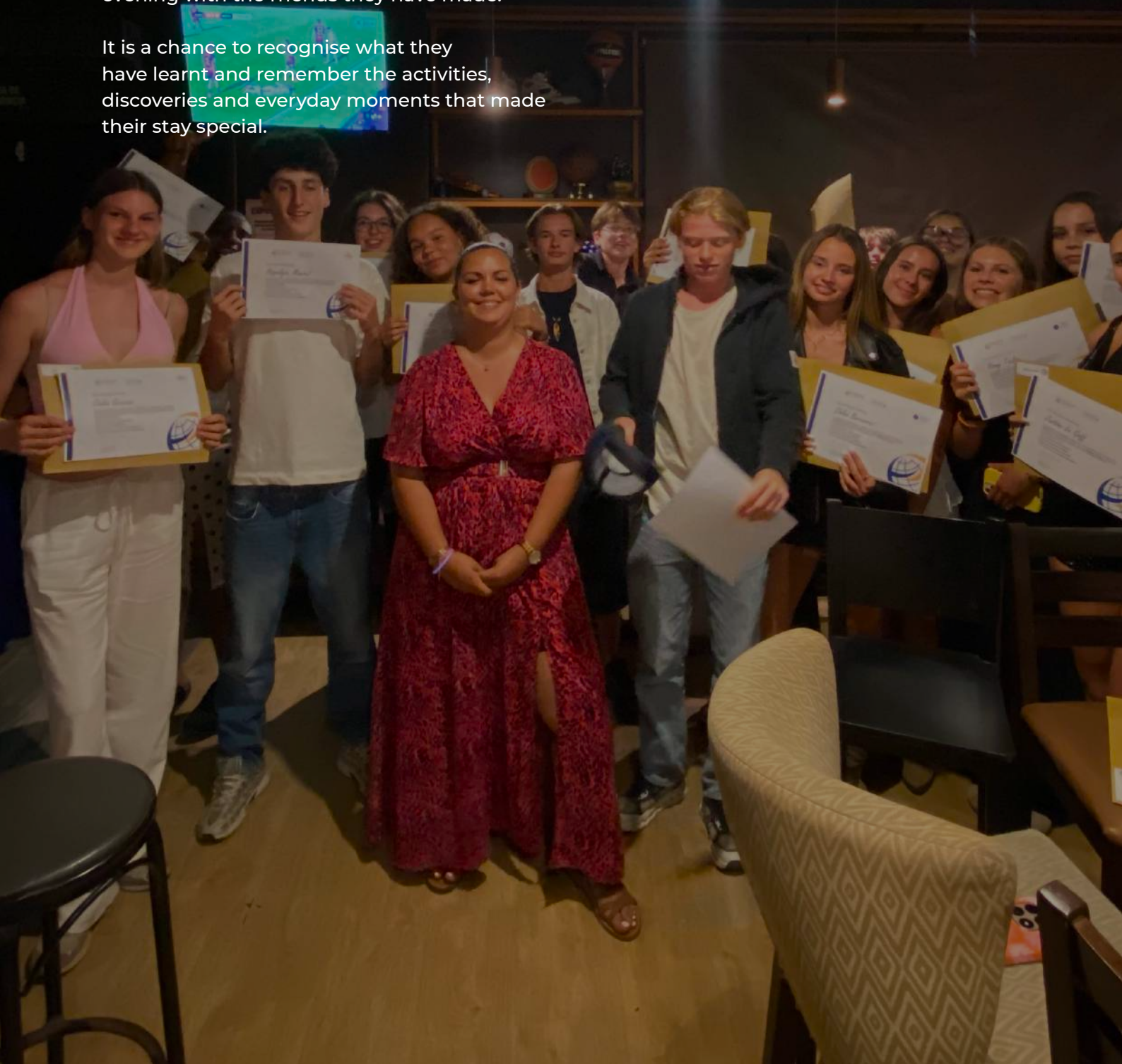
Farewell Party

Premium Activities

More than a Language Course

Students stay in **4-star hotel accommodation** in Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, in shared rooms accommodating two or three students. Each room includes Wi-Fi and a private bathroom, providing a comfortable base for the camp's lessons and activities.

Both hotels are within walking distance of the school and Las Canteras Beach, so students move around the city on foot every day. Their location is marked on the map on page 4.

Full board includes breakfast, lunch and dinner. Meals are served at the hotel, except on full-day excursions, when lunch is provided as a packed lunch or at a local restaurant.

Located in central Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, Design Plus BEX Hotel combines contemporary interiors with a distinctive design. Its modern rooms and shared spaces provide a comfortable setting for students between lessons, excursions and time with their group.
