About Language Campus

Our story began in **2006**, sending students abroad as a study-travel agency — work we continue today. In 2008 we founded Language Campus to welcome students to the Canary Islands, and we now host young learners from different countries and backgrounds every summer.

Our approach combines high-quality language teaching with an engaging, communicative methodology designed to help students build confidence and use the language naturally. Courses follow the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), with students placed at the appropriate level and their progress monitored throughout the programme.

Our Tenerife Summer Camp is based in **Costa Adeje**, in the south of the island, with lessons at Wingate College. Its location allows students to combine language learning with sunshine, beaches, outdoor activities and some of the island's most memorable experiences.

During the Summer Camp, learning goes far beyond the classroom. Lessons are combined with activities, excursions and shared experiences that encourage students to practise the language, discover a new culture and make friends from around the world.

Classes are led by **qualified and experienced teachers** in a dynamic and supportive learning environment designed to keep young learners engaged and motivated.

Where We Are

Our Summer Camp is based in **Costa Adeje**, on the southwest coast of Tenerife, the largest of Spain's Canary Islands.

The group stays at Los Olivos Beach Resort, **right on the seafront**, with direct access to the beach. Lessons take place at Wingate College, with a private transfer from the hotel on teaching days.

OUR SUMMER CAMP INCLUDES

- **20 language lessons per week (15 hours)** in English or Spanish, taught by qualified and experienced teachers.
- **International groups of up to 20 students** with dedicated supervision and one monitor per group.
- **3-star hotel accommodation** on the seafront in Costa Adeje, with a private transfer to the school on teaching days.
- **Full board** with breakfast, lunch and dinner included — lunch at a local restaurant on full-day excursions.
- **Airport transfers** coordinated for arrivals and departures
- **4 half-day activities and excursions per week**, combining culture, sightseeing, beach time and active experiences.
- **4 full-day excursions** over a two-week stay, discovering Tenerife's most iconic places and landscapes.
- **Evening programme** with the group, from the welcome meeting to the Farewell Party.

*Maximum class size of 20 students, with one dedicated monitor per group.

Learning by Doing

At Language Campus, language learning goes beyond textbooks. Our Summer Camp methodology is based on **practical communication**, collaborative tasks and real-life experiences that encourage students to use the language actively and with confidence.

Our programmes follow the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) and develop all key communication skills: listening, speaking, reading, writing, interaction and mediation.

Lessons are adapted to students' levels and learning needs, building on what they already know while helping them develop new skills in an engaging and supportive environment.

Most importantly, our classes are led by **qualified and experienced teachers** who know how to motivate young learners, encourage participation and make language learning an enjoyable part of the summer experience.

Example programme only. The order of the days changes between groups and rounds — arrivals and departures are agreed with each agency, so no two groups follow the same sequence. Premium activities are available at an additional cost.

A Week at the Camp

Every week combines **20 language lessons across four teaching days**, four half-day activities and two full-day excursions, plus an evening programme with the group. A private transfer takes the group from the hotel to the school on teaching days.

Depending on the number of groups and the classrooms available, timetables often alternate week by week: one week of morning classes with afternoon activities, the next the other way round. Each group receives its confirmed timetable before arrival.

Siam Park

Get ready for one of the most exciting days of the Summer Camp. Located in the south of Tenerife, Siam Park has been recognised as the **No. 1 water park in the world** for ten consecutive years through Tripadvisor's Travellers' Choice awards.

With spectacular water attractions, giant waves, thrilling slides and immersive tropical surroundings, students enjoy a full day of fun, excitement and shared experiences with friends.

The group spends the whole day in the park with their monitors, moving between attractions at their own pace.

FULL-DAY EXCURSION · TEIDE + LOS CRISTIANOS

Mount Teide

Rising to **3,715 metres**, Mount Teide is the highest peak in Spain and — measured from its base on the ocean floor — one of the largest volcanoes on Earth. Around it stretches a caldera of lava fields, craters and rock formations shaped over millions of years.

A **UNESCO World Heritage Site** and the most visited national park in Spain, Teide feels like another planet: silence, altitude and colours that change with the light. The excursion continues in the afternoon on the south coast, in Los Cristianos.

Stand on a volcano. Look down on the clouds.



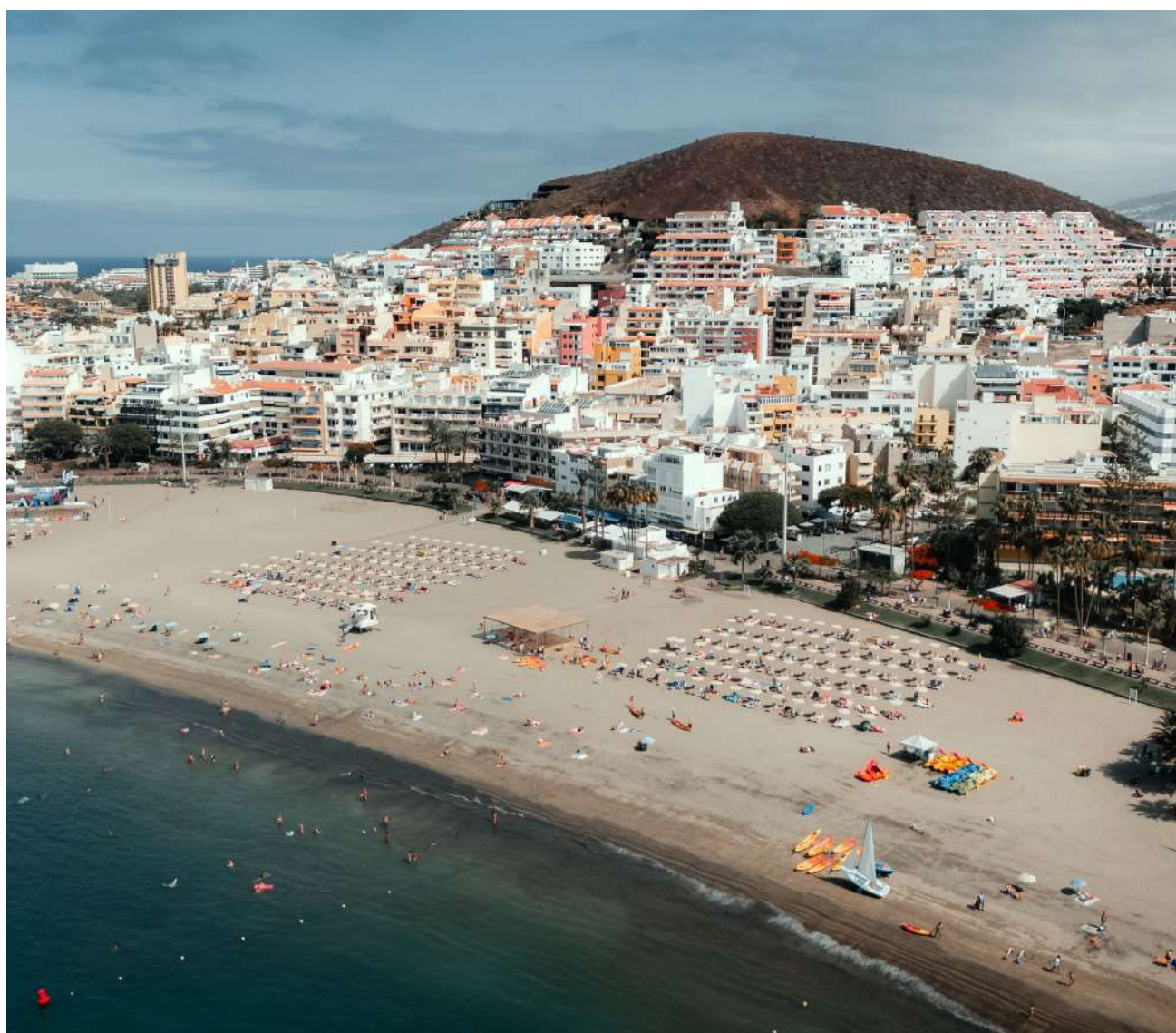
Los Cristianos

Back at sea level after the morning in the mountains, Los Cristianos offers a **lively coastal atmosphere** with seaside promenades, ocean views and a relaxed setting that is perfect for exploring on foot.

Its sheltered beach and harbour front give the group time to swim, walk and enjoy island life at a slower pace.

Barely an hour separates the summit from the shoreline, and that contrast is what makes this one of the most memorable days of the programme.

Santa Cruz de Tenerife

Discover the cultural and historic side of Tenerife in its capital. Santa Cruz combines lively streets, modern city life and a strong cultural identity.

The city is especially famous for its spectacular **Carnival**, one of Tenerife's most internationally recognised celebrations.

Walking through its avenues, squares and waterfront gives students a picture of everyday life on the island beyond the resorts of the south.

San Cristóbal de La Laguna

Nearby, San Cristóbal de La Laguna offers a completely different atmosphere. A **UNESCO World Heritage Site**, its historic streets, colourful architecture and traditional buildings reflect centuries of history.

Its lively pedestrian areas and university life give the old town an energy that students notice straight away.

Together, Santa Cruz and La Laguna are the chance to experience Tenerife beyond its beaches and discover the history, culture and everyday life of the island.

FULL-DAY EXCURSION

Games & Surf at El Médano

Spend a full day in one of the most iconic coastal spots in the south of Tenerife. With its natural setting, Atlantic waves and striking views of **Montaña Roja**, El Médano is a fantastic place to experience the island's outdoor lifestyle.

Students take part in a **professionally guided surf session** adapted to their level, combined with beach games, in a safe and supportive environment.

Ride the waves and experience Tenerife from the water.



Half-day activity

Jungle Park

Step into a lush world of nature and wildlife at Jungle Park, where tropical vegetation, scenic trails and a wide variety of animals create an exciting outdoor experience.

Students discover different species throughout the park and enjoy impressive live displays, including its well-known **birds of prey show**.

It's a fun and engaging way to spend time surrounded by nature, learning more about wildlife while exploring one of Tenerife's most distinctive attractions.

Half-day activities

Playa del Duque

Spend the afternoon at **Playa del Duque**, one of the most attractive beaches in the south of Tenerife, with its golden sand, clear waters and elegant seaside promenade.

Time to swim, unwind and enjoy the Atlantic with the group, a short walk from the hotel.

The beach chillout that follows is one of those unhurried moments where the language stops being a subject and becomes a conversation.

Bowling



A **bowling session** with the group: friendly competition, teams and a lot of noise.

Las Américas Beach

Enjoy the lively atmosphere of **Playa de las Américas**, its historic streets, colourful architecture and traditional buildings reflect centuries of history.

The afternoon begins with lunch at the **Hard Rock Cafe**, surrounded by its rock-inspired atmosphere and music, before heading down to the beach. Between the promenade, the shops and the shoreline, it is the afternoon that shows students the busiest, most cosmopolitan side of the south coast.

Half-day activity

Sports & Competition at Fañabé

Fañabé beach becomes the setting for **sport, games and friendly competition** by the Atlantic. Teams take on each other across a series of challenges, with everyone involved whatever their level.

Its calm waters and long sandy shore make it one of the best beaches in the south for a session with the whole group.

Between rounds there is time to swim and cool off, and the session often runs on until the sky over the Atlantic starts to change colour — one of those simple summer moments that make the Tenerife experience so memorable.

Beach Volley

Tenerife's beaches are the perfect court. **Beach volley**, football and group games, with mixed teams that change every round so everyone plays.

Half-day activity

Torviscas

A short walk along the coast from the hotel, **Torviscas** combines a sheltered beach with a busy marina and seafront promenade — a relaxed afternoon of swimming, walking and time with the group.

It is also the afternoon when the optional water activities are offered, for students who want to add something extra to the day.

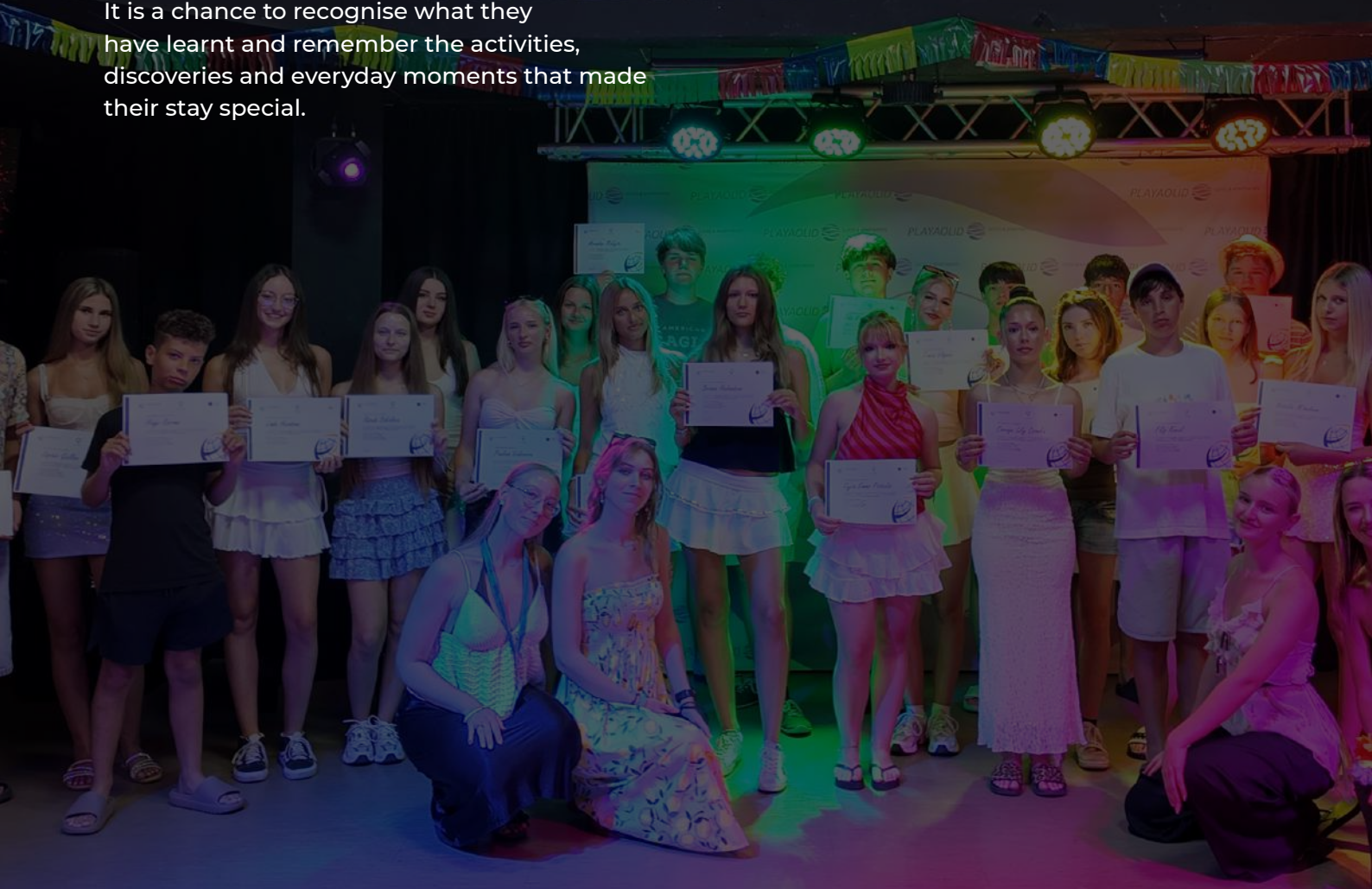
Farewell Party

Accommodation

Los Olivos Beach Resort

The group stays at **4Los Olivos Beach Resort**, a 3-star hotel right on the seafront in Costa Adeje, with direct access to the beach, two outdoor pools and open terraces. Students share rooms of three or four, each with a private bathroom and Wi-Fi.

Full board includes breakfast, lunch and dinner. Meals are served at the hotel, and on full-day excursions lunch is taken at a local restaurant. A private transfer takes the group to Wingate College on teaching days.
